As you know, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is responsible for administering the Federal Government's BioPreferredSM program. This initiative aims to increase the purchase and use of renewable, environmentally friendly biobased products while providing "green" jobs and new markets for farmers, manufacturers, and vendors.

In support of this effort, I am writing to request your cooperation in implementing a provision of the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (Farm Bill) requiring Federal agencies to give procurement preference to designated biobased products. USDA is committed to the success of the program and will be pleased to support you in your efforts.

I am enclosing a factsheet on the BioPreferredSM program that you and your management team may find of interest. If you would also kindly share this information with your agency's chief acquisition officer or other senior procurement official, we would be most appreciative.
